Job Summary

The general responsibility of the Groundskeeper is to maintain the SSBCC landscape at a high level of excellence and beauty.

Summary of Essential Job Functions

- Work to complete assignments given by supervisor.
- Maintain Grounds:
 - Keep lawns cut, cleaned, fertilized, and trimmed.
 - Restore or replant lawns as needed.
 - Complete assigned bed maintenance to include but not limited to pull weeds, straw, edge, etc.
- Keep grounds, walks, and streets clean of litter and debris and transport all campus refuse to dumpster or landfill.
- Maintain Equipment:
 - Daily checks of all equipment fluid levels and lubricate per established procedures and check for damage and/or needed repairs.
 - Maintain all grounds related equipment per established Preventative Maintenance Procedures.
 - Keep all equipment clean and stored in its designated location.
- Make safety a way of life. Help eliminate any and all hazards to our Guests, employees, and properties.
- Accept miscellaneous assignments as agreed upon with supervisor.

Job Requirements

Spiritual

- In all aspects of personal, professional and spiritual life, exemplify Christ-like standards.

Life and Job Related

- High school graduate preferred, or job experience to compensate for this type job.
- Work experience in grounds work or related field preferred.
- Ability to organize, manage multiple tasks and details and to perform assigned duties in a pleasant and competent manner.
- Ability to communicate (auditory and verbal) adeptly with guests, program personnel, and employees.

Physical

- Physical ability to operate at least 8 hours per day, 40 hours per week small to medium size tractors, and a commercial size gas powered weed eater and/or other similar equipment utilized in landscape maintenance operations.
- Physical ability or strength to lift, carry, and load onto a 4' high platform bales of straw, bags of fertilizer, cement blocks, etc. weighing up to 80 pounds.
- Ability to operate company vehicles.
- Ability to work outside in all weather conditions indigenous to Talladega County, Alabama.
- Ability to abstain from use of tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, and controlled substances.
